

# PUBLIC EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

## JOINT VENTURE OPPORTUNITIES AT Comprehensive Community-Based Rehabilitation Tanzania (CCBRT), Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

### 1. ABOUT CCBRT

Comprehensive Community-Based Rehabilitation Tanzania (CCBRT) is a locally registered non-governmental organisation established in 1994 and operating specialised healthcare services in Dar es Salaam and Moshi. CCBRT is the country's leading provider of super specialised services in disability, rehabilitative and maternal healthcare services while considering the community by providing services to the vulnerable people through a dedicated window supported by development partners/like minded donors.

In 2022, CCBRT commissioned a purpose-built Maternal and Newborn Wing in Dar es Salaam to expand access to quality maternal healthcare for underserved women, including women with disabilities and former obstetric fistula patients. The facility has an inpatient capacity of approximately 200 patients.

As part of its long-term strategy, CCBRT plans and focus on the following areas in strengthening national healthcare capacity and sustainability: -

- (i) Establish business partnership with local or international partners in Healthcare Supply Chain (whole sale medical supplies, pharmaceuticals, radiology) and Support Services.
- (ii) Building own plant for producing assistive devices (Wheel chairs, audio devices etc). This can be done through JV or partnership on how to utilise the available building structure best and land in the CCBRT compound.
- (iii) Establish a Medical Training College from this year 2026 to ensure the human capital is well equipped in handling medical treatments.

### 2. PURPOSE OF THE EOI

In line with its vision and mission, CCBRT invites Expressions of Interest from qualified, experienced, and mission-aligned partners to enter into Joint Venture (JV) arrangements to utilise and develop available land and existing facilities within the CCBRT compound in Dar es Salaam.

The objective of the JV programme is to:

- Generate sustainable, non-donor income to support CCBRT's healthcare services; and
- Safeguard CCBRT's core commitment to serving vulnerable populations.

All JV arrangements will be structured to preserve CCBRT's long-term stewardship of its assets while enabling partners to invest capital, expertise, and operational capacity.

### 3. INDICATIVE JV OPPORTUNITY AREAS

Proposals may include, but are not limited to, the following areas:

1. Healthcare Supply Chain (whole sale medical supplies,

pharmaceuticals, radiology, specialised diagnostic services) and Support Services  
Pharmaceutical wholesaler, medical supplies warehousing, radiology services and related services aligned with CCBRT's clinical focus areas.

2. Assistive devices production and allied health services  
Establishing plant for assistive devices production (Wheel chairs, audio devices and other devices which aim to reduce heavily reliant on importation for rehabilitation devices and supportive services.
3. Medical Education and Training Infrastructure  
Student hostels, training facilities, and related infrastructure supporting CCBRT's planned Medical Training College.
4. Social Enterprise Facilities use  
Office space for social enterprise facilities that are compatible with a hospital environment.
5. Innovative Services for Vulnerable Populations  
Ethical and socially responsible innovations that improve access, affordability, efficiency, or quality of care.

Partners may propose the use of existing facilities, new developments, or a blended approach, subject to internal approvals and regulatory compliance.

Applicants may submit proposals addressing a single opportunity area or multiple areas, provided that each proposal clearly aligns with CCBRT's mission and demonstrates strong operational feasibility.

### 4. PARTNERSHIP PRINCIPLES

All JV proposals must:

- Align with CCBRT's mission, Vision and values.
- Balance financial sustainability with measurable social impact
- Comply with applicable healthcare, safety, zoning, and regulatory standards
- Respect the integrity and operational requirements of a healthcare environment

### 5. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Interested parties should submit:

1. Cover letter outlining interest and alignment with CCBRT
2. Organisation profile and legal documentation
3. Conceptual JV proposal outlining structure, roles, and indicative returns
4. Evidence of financial and technical capacity
