CCBRT is Tanzania's largest local provider of disability and rehabilitation services in the country. We prevent lifelong disabilities wherever possible, and are therefore also engaged in extensive maternal and newborn healthcare (MNHC) activities including obstetric fistula repairs. Our Maternity and Newborn Wing serves as a referral centre for high risk and emergency deliveries in the region of Dar es Salaam and the Eastern Zone of Tanzania.

The role

The post-holder, reporting to the Chief Operating Officer will provide strategic leadership and oversight of CCBRT's procurement department to ensure that we meet and exceed our commitment to building transparent, standardized, ethical and safe practices that provide value for money. The Post-holder will identify opportunities for improvement especially if these enable procurement to be completed more rapidly with no loss of rigour. The Post-holder will review our current arrangements and revise these where necessary; create and maintain KPIs initiating correcting action as appropriate; create new policies and practices; train staff and strengthen organizational capacity; and bring best practice and industry standards to CCBRT.

The successful candidate will drive value for money, operational efficiency and effectiveness across CCBRT's procurement and supply chain functions, including warehouse and inventory management. The post-holder will support effective planning and execution of major procurements, ensure optimal stock availability and inventory control, strengthen warehouse operations, and oversee the safe, efficient and accountable storage and distribution of goods. They will establish and monitor robust policies, procedures, key performance indicators (KPIs) and internal controls to enhance procurement, warehousing and supply chain performance while ensuring compliance with organisational and donor requirements. Above all, the post-holder will embody CCBRT's values, fostering a culture of integrity, collaboration, innovation, accountability and excellence.

The candidate

- A minimum of a degree in Procurement, must be registered with the procurement and Supplies Professionals and Technician Board (PSPTB) and an authorized supplies officer or Stock Verifier
- Extensive experience (minimum of 8 years) within the Procurement sector in a leadership position.
- Experience in the health and NGO sector is an added advantage
- Ability to influence and negotiate effectively with internal and external stakeholders.
- Proven capability to work with cross-functional teams, with a collaborative mindset.

- Proven track record in effective Contract & Risk Management
- Excellent I.T skills with the capability of using software packages such as SAP
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills both in English and Swahili
